- Think of a creative, eye-catching, clear and concise presentation title
- Carefully write and review your abstract submission
- Keep your abstract to less than 2,500 characters.
- If a list is included, please provide a numbered list instead of a bulleted list.

When preparing your abstract, focus on clearly articulating the following:

- Purpose of your presentation
- Benefit and relevance to the industry
- Sufficient detail to show 30 minutes of content
- Alternatives evaluated and project status
- Key findings and conclusions
- Unique aspects of your project
- Omit any graphics or attachments (text only)
