Want to improve the likelihood your paper gets accepted?

1. Complete your submission by the deadline (Oct 28, 2022). Submittal must be complete with speaker information, presentation title, and abstract. Identify all presenters at the time of submission.
2. Please ensure, to the greatest extent possible, that all presenters will be available for both days of technical presentations at the conference (Monday March 27, 2023, and Tuesday March 28, 2023).
3. Think of a creative, eye catching presentation title (that's not too long).
4. Carefully write your abstract, or a narrative description of your presentation.
 - Abstracts should be approximately 400-750 words.
 - When preparing your abstract, focus on clearly articulating the:
 - Purpose of your presentation
 - Benefit and relevance to the water/wastewater industry
 - Provide enough details to show 50-minutes of content
 - Alternatives evaluated and project status
 - Key findings and conclusions
 - Unique aspects of your project
 - Omit any graphics or attachments. Abstract should be text only. If a list is included, please provide a numbered list instead of a bulleted list.
